



Back flushing the Group Heads



1. Place half a teaspoon of espresso cleaner in a blind filter basket.



2. Lock the handle into the grouphead as though you were pouring a shot.



3. Engage pump for no more than 10 seconds at a time. The powder will thicken and foam, bringing coffee residue with it.



4. Continue to turn the pump on and off, for a few seconds at a time. Usually you will need to repeat this around 8 or 10 times.



5. After the pump is disengaged be sure to note if foam is being discharged out of the dump valve.



6. Continue until water in blind filter is free of any coffee and water. from dump valve is running clear.



Porta-filter Handle Maintenance



1. Clean the porta-filter handles every day. Coffee residue builds up quickly!



2. Ensure that the spring clip is removed and kept safe for cleaning.



3. Rinse and scrub thoroughly, there should be no coffee residue left at all.



4. The pouring spout covers should be removed and cleaned on a weekly basis .



5. Most are simply held in by a screw and are easy to remove.
